Travel tips to the Department of Economics

If you come by **airplane** catch the AEROBUS at the airport (some 4 Euros) and stop in via Ugo Bassi. Here, at the same bus stop, change and take bus n. 25 and get out after 3-5 minutes in Strada Maggiore's last stop. You just need the ticket bought on the AEROBUS.

If you come by **train** just get bus 25 outside the railway station and stop in Strada Maggiore. You can buy the ticket on the bus for 1 Euro.
